Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to confirm my instruction to you that Glodwick Infant and Nursery School will be closed to all children except those who are identified by the Government as Vulnerable and those who have parents who work for the NHS, Police and Fire Service. We will do all we can to stay open for the children of these families.

Your child will need to stay at home with you from Monday 23 March 2020 until further notice.

This is a national closure of schools and not our personal decision. We will re-open as soon as we can and let you know this by text and on our website:

What we will continue doing while your child is at home:

It is important for your child to understand that they are not on holiday and that they must continue to learn. We expect your child to do Maths, Reading and Writing every day.

Your child's teacher has given your child a learning pack which needs to be used every day.

We have asked for an email address for each child so that the teachers can get in touch with extra working and help if your child needs support.

We have set up Class Dojo for you and your child to be able to communicate with their teacher and their class.

We have put links on our website for you to access 'fun' learning activities for your child to do with you at home.

You can contact your child's teacher, using the class email address or class dojo. Class dojo is the simplest way to get in touch. There are instructions on the internet on how to use Class dojo.

The BBC are providing lessons on TV. Check this out on their website and iplayer.

At the moment a lunch will only be provided for the children who are in receipt of Pupil Premium. At the moment we do not know how this will happen.

This is as much as we know right now and we appreciate your continued patience with as we deal with this ever-changing situation.

We understand that this latest news will have an impact on you and your family. It is not a good situation for any of us. We will continue to keep in touch with any updates as the situation develops.
